unpredictability. Jesus being sound asleep in a boat rocked by the storm is more than an incident story that shows Jesus's power to save and, especially, the disciples' general lack of faith. I think the disciples displayed a lot of faith by waking Jesus up and saying to him, *"Teacher, do you not care that we are perishing?"* If they had no faith in him, why would they wake him up? Did they just want him to join in the general panic attack? They probably didn't know what he could do but he was their go to man.

This incident occurred earlier on in his ministry. The questions he put to them, "Why are you afraid? Have you still no faith?" seem unfair because his disciples were only beginning to be exposed to who he was. They asked, "<u>Teacher</u>, do you not care...?" To them he was still just an amazing, charismatic and intriguing teacher, which is why they were flabbergasted that even the wind and the sea obeyed him.

I think, quite possibly, what Jesus was saying to them was, "You don't need to be afraid. You have still not grasped who I really am." Of course, they hadn't and even with this added chunk of new information about the nature and power of this man they were following, they would continue to underestimate his power and his wisdom right up until Pentecost. They would continue to be small boats rocked by storms of chaos, disorder and the unknown – all things that Jesus is complete Lord of.

We are no different. Seas of chaos, disorder and the unknown really rock our boats. But we have enough faith to try to wake up the Lord by praying, "Lord, do you not care??" He absolutely does care and he absolutely is in control. What he asks of us is that we trust that he is awake, aware and in control. The storm gave the disciples an opportunity to add to their deposit of faith.

Our storms will do the same for us.



As I shared in my memo of May 24, 2024, Rev. Jan Grotkowski, S.D.S. was recently and unexpectedly called to a new assignment by his Religious Superior. After much prayer and discussion, the Diocese of Victoria Personnel Committee has discerned that Sacred Heart Parish, having experienced a number of changes over the past few years, is in great need of a period of stability.

Therefore, I announce today that Rev. Shijo George, new to the Diocese in December 2023, and here upon mutual agreement with the Eparchy of Mississauga, will be appointed Pastor of Sacred Heart Parish effective June 15, 2024. He will also continue to serve the Syro-Malabar faithful.

I appreciate the disappointment this will cause to the Holy Cross Parish community. While Holy Cross is without a pastor, I have appointed an Executive Committee to act as the de facto governing body for parish priorities, agendas, and direction. This Committee will be composed of Catherine Davis (Parish Pastoral Council Chair), Dave Begg (Finance Committee Chair), and John Bartle Clar (Appeal Team Leader). The lay leadership, dedicated staff, and community strength of Holy Cross Parish is edifying, and I am confident that the ability of Holy Cross to be light and salt for the Diocese of Victoria will continue.

I have also appointed an Executive Committee to serve St. Patrick's Parish in Victoria while Rev. Benson Asuming continues the process of immigrating to Canada. This Committee will be composed of Mark Redchurch (Parish Pastoral Council Chair), Peter Bray (Finance Committee Chair), and Theresa Smith (member of the Parish Personnel Committee),

Finally, I must announce today that Sr. Nancy Abarrientos RVM and Sr. Marife Macalam RVM, Pastoral Administrators for the West Coast Parishes (Holy Family Parish in Ucluelet, St. Francis of Assisi Parish in Tofino, and St. Lawrence Parish in Ahousaht), have been called by their Religious Superior to new assignments elsewhere in Canada, effective August 2024. I wish to thank the Sisters for their service in our Diocese, and ask you to join me in prayer that their new assignments may be a source of spiritual growth and renewal.

We are most grateful for the dedicated and faithful people who minister in our Diocese. Your continued support and prayers for the ongoing pastoral needs of the Diocese of Victoria are much appreciated.
